

Shoreline Grants for Lake George

Available to residents at Lake George

Anoka Conservation District has staff and resources to help you manage your lakeshore for stability, access, and wildlife.

PROJECT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS



Native plant buffer at water's edge

- Add beautiful flowers, stabilizing grasses, and habitat.
- Need not cover the entire shoreline – can exclude your dock, beach, and other active use areas.



Stabilizing eroding shorelines

- Correct erosion with re-grading, natural-fiber erosion blankets and logs, vegetation, rock, or others.
- Rock may be used where warranted, but the least amount practical.
- Must include a native plant buffer.

Purpose: To fix erosion & plant lakeshore buffers.

Landowner Contribution: Approximately 35% by cash or your in-kind labor. Grant percentage increases with the area of native plant buffer and in-lake aquatic vegetation you're willing to install.

Expiration: For projects in 2026 or 2027. Limited funds will be awarded until gone.

Technical help: Our staff will lead the design (with your input), permitting, & construction oversight.

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
